long or multiples of 1 beat.)*

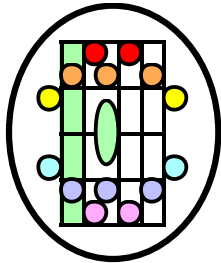


Colors of Long Notes

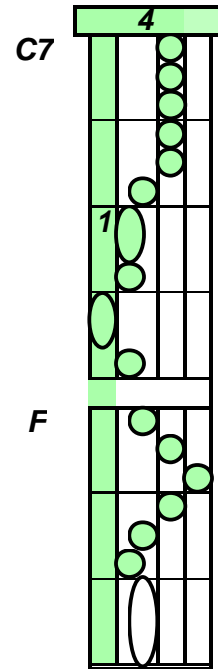
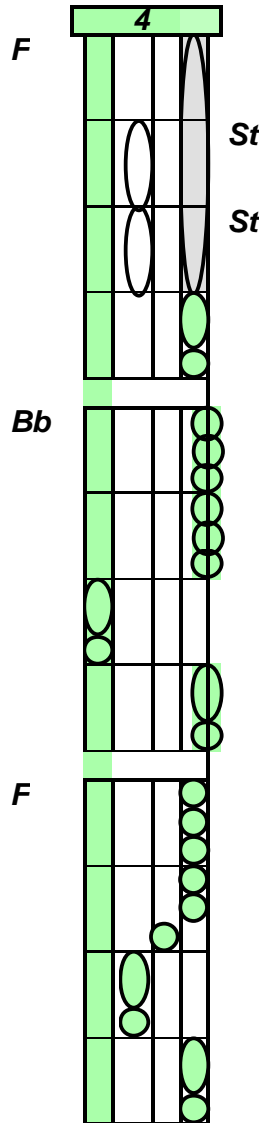
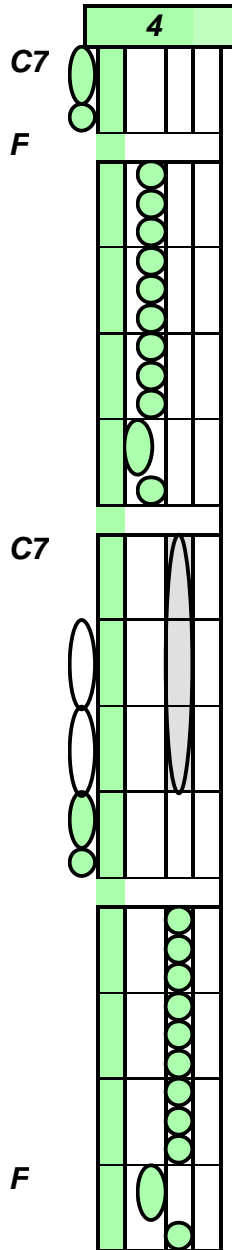
